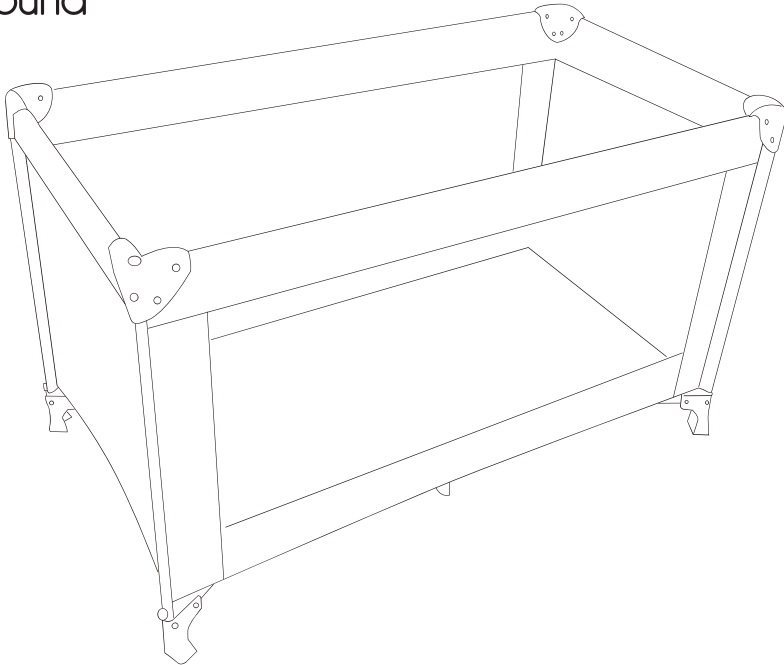

To assemble the Travel Cot

Unpack the Travel Cot

Remove the travel cot from the carry bag. Undo the Velcro straps and take the mattress off the travel cot. Fig. 1.

Open the Travel Cot

Pull two opposite corners of the travel cot outward to start unfolding it. Fig. 2.

Push the central lock handle downwards until all the top rails click and lock into place and the base becomes completely flat. The folding lock will engage automatically. Fig. 2a.

Place the Mattress

Lay the mattress inside the travel cot. Fig. 3.

Secure the Mattress

Thread the Velcro straps on the edges of the mattress through the slots in the base of the travel cot. Attach the straps to the matching Velcro pieces underneath the travel cot. Fig. 4.

The travel cot should now look like Fig. 4a.

Safety Information

The travel cot is ready for use, only when the locking mechanisms are engaged.

Check carefully that they are fully engaged before using the travel cot.

To Fold the Travel Cot

Remove the Mattress

Take the mattress out of the travel cot.

Unlock and Lift

Rotate the folding lock handle in the center of the travel cot's base 90 degrees.

Lift the handle upwards in one smooth motion. Fig. 5.

IMPORTANT: Ensure the handle is rotated before lifting it upwards to avoid potential damage.

Fold the Travel Cot

Pull the top corners of the travel cot inward toward the center until fully closed. Fig. 6.

The folded travel cot should now look like Fig. 7.

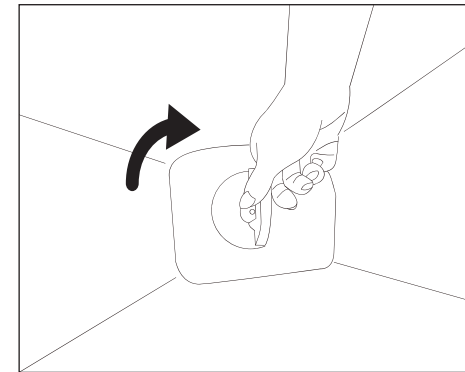

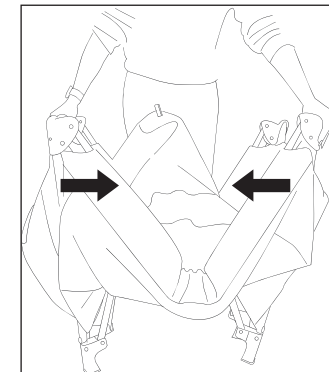

To Store the Travel Cot

Wrap the Mattress

Stand the folded travel cot upright and wrap the mattress around it.

Note: The mattress has 5 foldable boards. Fold the side with the Velcro and buckles inward on itself first. This helps the mattress wrap around the travel cot.

Thread the Velcro straps at the ends of the mattress through the buckles. Pull tight to secure. Figs. 8 and 9.

Pack the Travel Cot

Place the travel cot into the carry bag.

Align the mattress handle with the handle opening on the bag. Fig. 10.

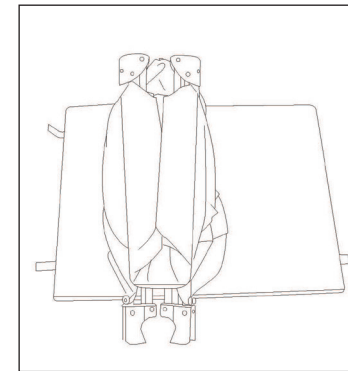

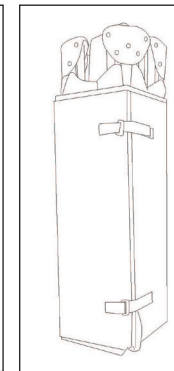
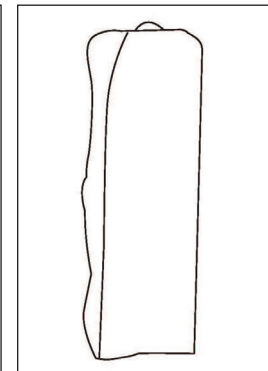

General Care:

- The correct use and maintenance of this travel cot is essential.
- Do not leave the travel cot in direct sunlight for long periods of time as this will cause the fabrics to fade.
- Always store in a dry place.

Cleaning:

- Fabric covers, trims and the carry bag may be sponged clean with a mild detergent and warm water. Dry in the open position in a ventilated area and out of direct sunlight.
- The covering fabric is not removable.
- Metal parts can be cleaned with a damp cloth then wiped dry.
- Clean plastic parts with a mild soap and water solution.

Maintenance:

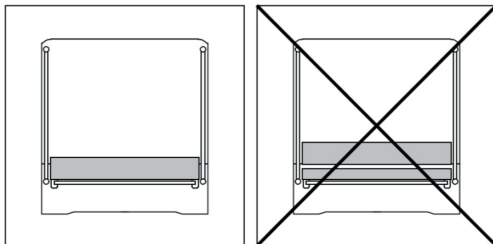
- Regularly inspect for loose, damaged or missing parts.
- Use the travel cot in accordance with the instructions; failure to do this or misuse may invalidate your warranty and be dangerous for the user.
- All assembly fittings should always be tightened properly. Fittings should be checked regularly and retightened as necessary.

Extra information:

- Unlike cots that have rigid sides the Sleeptight travel cot has flexible sides. As a result the mattress is specially designed to prevent a suffocation hazard. The mattress has a solid base, a specific length and width and is less than 25mm thick in order to meet the relevant safety standards. Using a thicker or differently sized mattress may allow a child's head to get between the mattress and the side of the travel cot causing suffocation. This mattress size is 117cm x 58cm and is designed so that the maximum gap between the mattress and the sides and ends does not exceed 30 mm.
- Do not use for a child that is able to climb out, reaches 86 cm in height or weighs more than 15kgs. (Whichever is first).
- Intended for use by children under 3 years of age.
- Never allow other children to play with the product.
- The travel cot is designed for baby whilst sleeping not as a restraint device.

Safety Warnings:

- **WARNING:** Your child's safety is your responsibility.
- **WARNING:** Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- **WARNING:** Do not use the cot if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer.
- **WARNING:** Do not leave anything in the cot or place the cot close to another product, which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind / curtain cords.
- **WARNING:** Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- **WARNING:** Only use the mattress sold with this cot, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards.



- Ensure that the product is correctly assembled before use; with the top bars locked straight, the centre foot firmly on the ground and the mattress in position.
- Use only the mattress supplied with this product and ensure it remains in position. Do not use pillows.
- Do not allow a child to lift the sides of the mattress up.
- Position the product on a level and stable surface
- Keep the product away from trailing cords and flexes.
- Do not use for more than one child at a time.
